

## 2010/2011 Supply List

Children in Levels 1, 2 & 3 need to bring the following items to Open House on August 27, 2010:

- 1 4oz bottle of Elmer's white glue
- 1 count box broad Crayola WASHABLE markers (no RoseArt please)
- 1 24 count box Crayola crayons (no RoseArt please)
- 1 ream white copy paper
- 1 change of clothes in a Ziploc bag – labeled with child's full name

In addition to the above items:

Level 1 bring in:

- 1 8 count box of Crayola LARGE washable crayons

Level 2 bring in:

- 1 4 pack of 5oz containers of Play-doh

Level 3 bring in:

- 1 – 1 inch, 3-ring binder
- 1 rectangle box of Kleenex

Childcare AND Kindergarten children will rest on a child sized cot. For their comfort, we recommend a “Kid-Napper”— we have found this nap set to be very convenient to use and store. They are machine washable, and have Velcro fasteners for easy roll up and a nylon bag for storage. It combines a thickly quilted fabric mat and non-removable pillow with an attached top sheet. These rest mats are made in America by American workers. These are currently available in the school office in a variety of styles and colors. The cost is \$28. We will also have them on sale during our Open House on August 27, 6:30-8:00 p.m. If you choose not to purchase a napper, you must provide your child with a blanket and child size pillow to keep at school on a weekly basis. For sanitary reasons, these items must fit into a SMALL backpack or bag that zips or ties at the top.
